## **Thread Paint Lettering Workshop Supply List**



**Basic Sewing, Sewing Machine and Rotary Cutting Supplies.** Be sure to bring Walking & Free Motion Feet.

## **Project Basics:**

• Minimum of 3 fat quarters.

Choose coordinated fabrics for background, inner border, main border and backing. The inner border and the backing can be the same fabric. The background fabric should not be too busy so that the lettering will show up.

- ½ yard medium weight stabilizer (I use Pellon)
- ½ yd. low loft batting (I use Dream

Cotton)

- 6" x 6"piece double sided fusible (I use Steam-a-Seam2 or WonderUnder)
- 8" x 8" piece of tracing paper

## Thread:

- Thread for piecing. (I use Superior Master Piece or Aurafil)
- Threads for quilting and lettering. Bring what you have! I like to use:
  - o OESD Isocord or Superior 40wt. Trilobal Polyester
  - Metallic threads are nice too. I use Superior.

## Precut to make workshop go faster:

- 8.5" x 8.5" background (cut 1)
- 1" x 8.5" inner border (cut 4)
- 2.5" x 8.5" main border (cut 2)
- 2.5" x 12.5" main border (cut 2)
- 12.5" x 12.5" backing (cut 1)

I will provide a sampling of chinese letters and words (Love, Peace, Joy, etc.) in the correct size font for the project.

Classroom will need a few irons. Students can share rotary cutter supplies if desired by the group.
