



**Supply List**  
**Lazy Landscape Quilt Workshop**  
**by Lisa Ellis**

- sewing machine
- 6 – 8 fat quarters of background fabric. (Choose the same color family of varying values (e.g., B/W, Green, or Beige))
- 3-4 tidbits (or nice size scraps) of fabric for petals (choose a flower color that will contrast with the background (e.g., purple, pink))
- ½ yd. complementary border fabric (optional)
- 1 yd. backing fabric
- ¼ yd. binding fabric
- 1 yd. batting (I like a very thin loft - 100% cotton. Quilter's Dream Cotton – Request is a favorite)
- complementary thread for piecing background
- assortment of threads for machine quilting the background and flowers (I like Isacord embroidery and Superior' Rainbow variegated threads)
- 1 yd. of double stick fusible. (I like Steam-a-Seam2 or Wonder Under)
- scissors
- cutting mat, rotary cutter, ruler
- optional: 1 yd. lightweight tulle (if you want to learn a tip for machine quilting)
- ironing board and iron available at workshop
