Praise Quilt Workshop

Bring to the Workshop:

- 6 – 8 fat quarters of background fabric. (Choose the same color family of varying values (e.g., Orange, Green, Blue, or Beige))
- ½ yd. of a very dark fabric for the appliqué. (I like Michael Miller Fairy Frost – Onyx available from Webfabrics.net)
- 1 yd. of double sided fusible. (I like to buy yardage of Steam-a-Seam2 from the 18” roll. Available from equilter.com. It’s fine to have the 12” wide fusible which most quilt stores carry.)
- scissors (paper and fabric)
- permanent marker. (I like Ultra Fine Point Black Sharpie)
- cutting mat, rotary cutter, ruler (at least 18” long)
- sewing machine (Optional: If you want to practice the lettering in class, bring your machine.)

Needed to complete your project after the workshop:

- ½ yd. complementary border fabric (optional)
- ¼ yd. binding fabric (optional)
- 1 yd. backing fabric
- 1 yd. batting. (I like a very thin loft - 100% cotton. Quilter’s Dream Cotton–Request)
- Assortment of threads for machine quilting the background and lettering. (I like Superior’s Rainbow variegated threads for quilting and Superior metallic threads for lettering)
- Print out of lettering at 135 font of your desired inscription. (I will bring samples for students to practice this technique so you can decide what lettering you want to do later)

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
