



**Supply List for  
Transparency and Value for Quilters 101

- Straight Edge for drawing lines (at least 15")
- Square template (15" – 18") (Only bring if you have one. We can share within the class.)
- Circle Templates (at least 2 sizes, 3"- 6") (saucers or other objects are fine)
- Tracing paper (1 yd of 18" wide). Only bring if you have it. We can share within the class)
- Depending on your desired construction technique:
  - Fusible - double sided 3/4 yd of 24" wide (no sew method which will be the fastest)
  - OR Freezer Paper (sew method)
- Pencil
- Colored pencils (4-5 colors)
- Sharpie (black – fine point)
- Highlighter or magic marker (any color)
- Assorted Fabrics
  - 2 complementary colors (e.g. orange/blue)
  - OR 1 color and blacks/whites
  
  - Bring as many different values (light, mediums and darks) as practical in fat 1/8s or fat 1/4s or large scraps
  - Textured prints, tone-on-tone and small prints are best for this technique
- Sewing machine to the second class if you choose the sewing method with freezer paper
- Scissors
